### Week of June 14

**Treasure Hunt Missoula** – Become a summer time detective! Help solve daily clues that will lead us to treasure! Searches will take us around Missoula for fun summer experiences. We will playfully explore disguises, treasure maps and riddles. Younger children will have nature scavenger hunts and uncover buried treasure near the school. Sleuth your way through a creative week of fun! Friday is sure to produce a surprise!



### Week of June 21

**Art in the Park**– Come let your creativity flow as we explore nature with a new backdrop each day. Children work with a variety of mediums in creative expression. Young artists will choose their best work to be displayed for First Friday in July.

### Week of June 28

**Bridges to Learning** – Join us for an exploration of bridges; learn how different structures support weight. Build model bridges and test their strength. Draw and photograph bridges and have fun with art and construction. Learn history of Higgins Street Bridge and how bridges connect our community. We will only walk over pedestrian bridges near the school.

### Week of July 6 (Tuesday through Friday)

**Magical Theatre** – Sign up for days of magic and transformation! Make your own wand and magic potion. We will learn how things change through simple science experiments. Tom from Montana Clown Works will perform magic and teach us tricks to practice for our own *Magic Finale* to Wow parents!



### Week of July 12

**Let Your Garden Grow** – Roll up your sleeves and grab your garden gear...the fantastic summer climate of Missoula allows us to enjoy local fruits, herbs and produce! This week we

will learn the wonder and beauty of gardening and visit local family plots around town including the fantastic Peas Farm! Come and help name our worm farm!

### Week of July 19

**Kids Cook** – Bring your appetite this week! We will explore cooking and creating with locally grown ingredients! Recipes will be inspired from children's interests, family favorites and the expertise of local everyday chefs! The week will end with a delicious outdoor feast to share!

### Week of July 26

**Buggin' Around** - Join us in learning about social insects. How are their colonies organized? How do they communicate with one another? Kaitylyn Brooks will share her knowledge of bee keeping and other social insects through engaging activities for all ages.

### Week of August 2

**Wet and Wild** – Stroll down local trails with teachers and new friends to explore the wonder of Missoula area recreation spots.
